

Club Aerobatics RC Drag Racing Car Rules

The rules and guidelines outlined in this document are set in place to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all members and visitors of the club.

Permitted Radio Control Cars and Guidelines

CA caters for all RC Cars, 1/5th, 1/8th and 1/10th gas, nitro and electric cars are permitted, however the track length, setup and design is for 1/5th scale and thus may not suit smaller scale cars.

Drag Racing Rules

- Race format is as follows:
 - Elimination rounds
 - Finals
- Race opponents will be drawn at the start of the event and the initial pairing recorded on the elimination chart.
- The rules will be double elimination so you need to lose twice to be out of the race.
- Unmatched competitors will receive an automatic bye.
- Races are run on a track measuring exactly 40.23m (132ft) with a brake and turn around area longer than 20m
- Gas and Nitro cars must be started behind the starting line and engines killed again before leaving the track
- Races will be started by the Stig (judge) with a clear countdown 3, 2, 1, GO! or Steet Outlaw start with a flash light or with drag starting lights. This depends on what is available and is up to the Stig's discretion.
- Early starters will be warned once and disqualified the on the second violation.
- Races will be judged by Stig Number Two at the finishing line - declaring and recording the winner.
- If available a video camera will be setup at the finishing line to resolve any disputes and the Stig will have the final say.
- In the event of a tie being declared the race will be repeated until a winner is declared.
- The starting and finishing lines will be clearly marked with white lines across the runway.
- The competitors will race the elimination rounds, two at a time, with the fastest car (crossing the finish line first) winning the round.
- The finals will be held between the two winners of the double elimination rounds.
- If you are concerned about some someone or something, bring it to the attention of the Stig as soon as possible.
