



Pretoria Radio Flyers: Absolute Safety Operating Procedures

1. Children and pets are not permitted on the taxiways and runways.
2. Flying a model aircraft within 6 hours of consuming alcohol is strictly prohibited.
3. All aircraft must be restrained while range checking.
4. When a full-size aircraft approaches, all RC aircraft must land immediately.
5. Take-off and landings must be announced.
6. Helicopters may be started but not run above $\frac{1}{4}$ throttle in the pit area.
7. The maximum height of 122 meters (400ft.) above ground level may not be exceeded.
8. All jet aircraft **MUST** have a suitable fire extinguisher.
9. Designated flying areas are, shown on the notice board and must be adhered to.
10. The intentional chasing of birds and wildlife is forbidden.
11. Engine starts and engine runs must be done in the starting bays.
12. All electric models must make use of a throttle cut switch and in on position while in the pit area until ready for flight.
